Doppelgangers – What are they?

In May of 2010 the team and I went to Waverly Hills Sanatorium in Louisville, KY for a private investigation and had a great time. When we go on these "pay event" investigations we never know what we will "see", "hear", or learn about the paranormal. It was on this trip that we learned of a term used in the paranormal field, Doppelgangers.

At one point in the night the security guard / tour guide came up to check on us and see how things were going. We were startled and told him, "Oh wow, you startled us. We could have sworn you just went by a few minutes ago." He replied, "Yeah I get that sometimes. I'm told I have a doppelganger here". He went on to say, "Several tour groups have reported that to us and some even report that my doppelganger talks to them".

I left there wondering "what is a doppelganger?", but never really researched it. Then recently I saw a rerun episode of the CBS show "How I Met your Mother" and the entire episode was on doppelgangers. So that brought back that experience and lead me to want to research the topic.

Merriam-Webster Online Dictionary define a doppelganger as a ghostly counterpart of a living person.¹ In an article written by Niki Foster on Wisegeek.com she defines a doppelganger as something that can be the ghost of a living person or any other sort of physical double.² A third source, Wikipedia, define a doppelganger as a tangible double of a living person in fiction, folklore, and popular culture that typically represents evil.³ Even though each definition varies slightly they all agree that a doppelganger means a double of a living person.

How does this happen? After all, the most common perception of a ghost is that it is the spirit of someone who has passed away. How could someone who is living have an apparition of themselves walking around? Studying the word's etymology shows us it is derived from the German, combining the word 'doppel' (double) and 'ganger' (goer) or "double walker". When taken literally, it means one walking in the same manner belonging to an individual. In German folklore, it is thought that seeing a double of oneself walking alongside is an omen of imminent death. It is also believed by some that every individual has a doppelganger, commonly known as a "fetch".

Many legends speak of doppelgangers as being rather malevolent in nature. Beliefs about them vary from being unable to cast a shadow or a reflection to giving ill-intended advice. Some accounts speak of being haunted by one's doppelganger. As far back as Norse mythology, there are legends of the *vardogr*, or apparitions of the living that commit acts in real time before the person has an opportunity to do so.

It is often said that legends begin with a seed of truth. There have been accounts given of doppelgangers from very well-known people that, while not proof positive, certainly make one wonder. Percy Bysshe Shelley, one of the most heralded poets of all time, was said to have been visited by his own doppelganger while he was in Italy. Allegedly the apparition he saw pointed toward the Mediterranean Sea not long before Shelley died in a sailing accident in that very sea.

Other famous doppelganger sightings were Queen Elizabeth I, the French novelist Guy de Maupassant (who was said to have had a story inspired by his phantom), poet John Donne, and several others including Abraham Lincoln. One of the most talked about cases of a

Famous Haunts

Ohio State Reformatory (OSR), Mansfield, OH (aka Mansfield)

Located in north-central Ohio is the city of Mansfield. A nature lover's dream, it has over 30 parks as well as the Richland County Fairgrounds. It is home to the historic Renaissance Theater and the Mansfield Memorial Museum. There is however another landmark with a history meshed in violence and misery. Ironically, it was intended to redirect those whose paths had taken a wrong turn.

Ohio State Reformatory began construction on November 4, 1886. Levi T. Scofield was the architect and construction was overseen by F.F. Schnitzer. It was built on Camp Bartley, an 1861 Civil War training camp named after Ohio's 18th governor. The prison is a Romanesque Cathedral design with undertones of Victorian Gothic and Queen Anne, creating the spooky atmosphere of a ghost story. This is appropriate considering that many consider it quite an active place for spirits!

The prison was completed in 1910, but the first 150 men were transferred there in September of 1896. They were put to work on the prison sewer system and built the surrounding 25 foot wall. The six-tiered East Cell Block was finished in 1908 and remains the largest standing cell block in the world. It was intended as an intermediate prison, for those who had hope of reform. Before long, it became overcrowded and poorly maintained and the population included violent felons. The outdated building was closed as a prison in 1990 with over 150,000 inmates having served there and several incidents occurring that might haunt the building to this day.

On November 2nd 1926, parolee Phillip Orleck returned to the prison to aid in an inmate's escape. Officer Urban Wolford was at the west gate

tower when Orleck fatally shot him. Orleck was re-arrested and executed on July 18, 1927 at the Ohio Penitentiary. On October 2nd 1932, Frank Hanger, age 48, was beaten to death by twelve inmates with an iron bar. Inmates Merrill Chandler and Chester Probaski were found guilty of having delivered the blows and died by electrocution in 1935 at another prison.

On July 21, 1948 another horrible incident occurred. Former inmates John West and Robert (Murl) Daniels took OSR's honor farm superintendent John Niebel, his wife and daughter and murdered them in a field near Fleming Falls Road. It is thought they were actually after a prison guard by the name of Harris and had gone to Niebel's to get his address. West and Daniels then went on a two week killing spree, earning the name "Mad Dogs". They were caught in Van Wert, Ohio where West was killed in the ensuing shootout (some say by his own hand) and Daniels was captured and executed.

In November of 1950, Helen Bauer Glatke, the wife of the warden, suffered an accidental gunshot wound when she reached into a closet and a handgun fell out and discharged. She contracted pneumonia and died several days later. Her husband, Warden Arthur Lewis Glatke was employed at Ohio State Reformatory from 1935 until his death from a heart attack in his office February 10, 1959.

One of the worst areas was "the hole" for solitary confinement. 120 men were placed there for 30 days in 1957 following a riot with at least one man allegedly being murdered. The conditions of the "hole" were very poor and prisoners who spent time there spoke of only having one cup of water and one slice of bread per day. There were inmates who spent their last days at Mansfield, many of whom are buried in the nearby cemetery.

The prison was a set for several movies including "The Shawshank Redemption" (1993) and Air Force One (1997). Threats of demolition inspired the Mansfield Reformatory Preservation Society to be formed in 1995. They have since held many tours and events, with the proceeds going toward restoration and upkeep as well as hosting paranormal investigations. The prison has appeared as a location for the shows Ghost Hunters and Ghost Adventures.

NOTE: Several members of the team will be taking a paravan to Ohio State Reformatory in June and we are so excited about this trip. We are going along with another local paranormal group called Ghostland Society. We leave on May 31st for an all night investigation on June 1st. This is the first time for our team, but a repeat visit for the other team. We have several experiments we plan to try while there. Tools of the Trade

KII and Ghost Meters



KII Meter

Almost every paranormal investigator or investigation team has a KII and/or a Ghost Meter in their tool bag. These two tools are both EMF detectors that have been calibrated for use by paranormal investigators. The popularity of these tools has increased over the last few years due to exposure on TV shows and ease of use....and in the case of the Ghost Meter the price is right.

There is a theory in the paranormal field that a sudden increase in the baseline Electromagnetic Fields (EMF) readings, known as spikes, for a location is a possible indicator of paranormal activity. Paranormal Investigators use EMF detectors to measure the baseline for a location, as well as any spikes that occur during an investigation. EMFs are given off by all power lines, power supplies, electronic equipment, and any device that uses power. Hence, why it is important to obtain a baseline of a location before an investigation is started.

Both of these tools can be used to gather a baseline reading, noting spikes at various points around the location. Additionally, both of these devices are sensitive to RF signals, such as from a cell phone, walkie talkie, and wireless router. If they are being used during an investigation, these sensitivities should be noted. During an investigation we do not carry our cell phones on us and make sure to turn off any wireless routers in the location. However, they are less sensitive to EMFs from electronics such as a TV or stereo.

While both the KII and the Ghost Meter have a similar use they do have some differences worth noting. The KII uses 5 colored LEDs that as the EMFs near the device increase more lights will light up. These lights make it easier to see in the dark. The Ghost Meter has three indicators that tell you when the EMFs have increased: a needle, LED light, and audio beep.

Additionally the KII only measures EMF in the Extremely Low Frequency (ELF) and in the Very Low Frequency (VLF), which sets it apart from other EMF detectors. The Ghost Meter has been calibrated to ignore subtle EMFs such as the human body, but still has the sensitivity to detect other EMF fluctuations.

There are people that believe that the KII and Ghost Meters can be used to communicate with ghosts or spirits. For the KII they are asked to approach the device to make more lights come on and step away to make them go off. Then with a Ghost Meter they are asked to make it blink, for instance once for yes and twice for no. The theory being that if the devices are in a normal state and then start going off and they appear to be going off in conjunction with the questions, then something paranormal is manipulating the device.

At TnT Paranormal we do use these detectors during our investigations. However, we have found that there are many factors that can cause a false positive with them. In addition to wireless technology you have to watch for appliances that run on cycles, such as refrigerators, furnaces, and sump pumps. It is best to unplug them or turn them off at the breaker box if you can. Sometimes that is not an option though. Therefore, if we get spikes from these devices during an investigation we always use other devices, such as a Trifield or Mel-Meter to confirm the EMF spikes. Additionally, we do not use an EMF as proof positive of the paranormal. We must have either audio or video data to back that up.

We recommend having these devices in a tool kit, but make sure you understand their limitations and that false positives can be obtained. As long as you continue to be a skeptic when using them, you should be fine.

Paranormal Talk with Rev. Kathy

What's In a Name?

Poltergeist: (*noun*) From German origin. Miriam Webster; From the words *poltern* meaning 'to knock' and *geist* meaning 'spirit'. WordNet Princeton.Edu; A ghost that announces its presence with rapping and the creation of disorder.

The classic understanding of a *poltergeist* is a noisy ghost. We associate strange middle of the night taps on the walls, footsteps, unknown voices, dishes crashing in the kitchen and electronic interference with this basic definition of a haunting. When paranormal investigators rule out environmental or other rational causes and before calling unexplained activity a haunting, it might be a good idea to take a closer look at the *living* inhabitants of the home.

In the 1930's J.B. and Louisa Rhine began Parapsychological studies **the study for evidence of psychological phenomena*, on extrasensory perception at Duke University in Durham, North Carolina. Their studies went on to later include remote viewing and psychokinesis **the ability to move objects by mental effort*, otherwise abbreviated as PK. In these PK studies, it was found that many individuals had the ability to influence and manipulate objects in their environment without physically touching them. The power of the mind could will a light to turn off, a glass to move and a fan to turn without power. Test subjects could effectively harness mind over matter.

The practice of Parapsychology today studies inherently psychic individuals who are *agents* of such unexplained activity. The ability to influence the environment with the mind is there, though the individual responsible more often than not isn't aware of it. Chemical changes such as puberty, pregnancy, menopause, other health issues, long-term stress or suppressed anger can trigger PK. Ironically, when a team Parapsychologist finds reason to believe activity is due to PK phenomenon and the agent becomes aware of their role in such events, the activity often slows or even ceases.

A 'poltergeist' isn't always what we know it to be.

Ask TnT Paranormal

These questions were submitted by our readers, by our online subscribers, or at events.

What is a poltergeist?

Poltergeist means "Noisy Ghost" in German. The theory surrounding *Poltergeist* is that it is not a ghost but rather activity caused by kinetic energy given off by an agent. The agents most generally are adolescent females, but not always. This kinetic energy is given off by them due to mental stress or high emotions. This type of haunting and/ or activity is typically short-lived.

What is Pareidolia?

Another word for Pareidolia is a term we use in the paranormal field called Matrixing. It is the human mind's natural tendency to find familiar images and phrases and complex shapes, colors and sounds in their environment and evidence reviews. Matrixing is something you see a lot in orb pictures and/or entity pictures.

A good example of matrixing is when people see common shapes out of cloud, such as "that cloud is shaped like a duck". It is a similar concept with matrixing for photography. The viewer reviews a photo and sees a shape in the tree leaves or in a snowflake and thinks it's a face or something. When really it is just their mind trying to make sense of what they are seeing.

What's on Your Mind?

Paranormal Photography Tips

Lets look at basic night time photography tips. Remember this is just a basic guide as all cameras will vary slightly. You may still need to experiment to get the correct settings.

Flash: some cameras allow you to adjust your flash strength, I suggest turning it up all the way to increase your depth of field.

Night scene or night shot, some cameras have this and if your using a tripod fine but without one you stand a great chance of blur or light trails because night scene gives your camera a longer exposure time. Many mistakes are made here.

Exposure is the time your aperture is open. What happens in many cases you take a picture, your flash goes off and you lower your camera. Well many times your camera aperture is still open so the picture will show light trails or blurring of the brighter objects. You should not use a long exposure UNLESS your shooting off a tripod. Hearing is very important when taking pictures at night. You need to listen for your camera to finish a picture before you move it. I have seen many pictures claimed to be paranormal that were up to 8 seconds exposure times. YOU WILL GET MOVEMENT unless shooting off a tripod. The longer your exposure the more movement in your picture becomes see thru. See those claimed apparition on the internet where a person is see through? Its movement with long exposure. See light trails? These are long exposure. Exposure is measured by f-stops Remember the lower the F-stop the more light your camera lets in.

F1 being largest F 64 being a pin hole Now your camera may be limited so select a low setting so more light enters your camera.

ISO: ISO speed affects the shutter speed / aperture combinations you can use to obtain correct exposure. The higher the ISO the more pixilation you get. Now using a flash at night you want an ISO that is appropriate. 400 to 640 are good all around settings. If you have a 12 mega pixel or higher camera you can even go up to an 800 ISO. Do not go higher unless your shooting off a tripod without a flash. Also do not drop to a 200 or 100 ISO unless your shooting off a tripod WITH flash.

Foreign objects in your picture, when using a flash any foreign particle, from lint to pollen, even moisture appear as objects in your picture if they are near your lens, they often give the illusion of being further away from the lens. Remember your shooting in 2D. Many small point and shoot cameras catch a sleeve, a finger even camera straps or lens cap strings in the flash. If possible use a lens hood as this helps eliminate some of these issues. These appear as a bright objects often reported as ghosts or a vortex. But once again understand your equipment.

Shadows: Many times a dark shadow or spot is misperception. A finger blocking a portion of a flash will appear as a dark shape. When taking pictures an object off the side can appear as a larger shape when the flash creates a shadow. I have seen a vase as a cowboy.

Always try and pay attention to your **surroundings**. Take control shots with the lights on as a reference. When taking pictures at night take a couple from each position so you have another picture to reference.

Most digital cameras have an **exif** file attached to your pictures. They explain what settings your camera had. You can look at these to see if a flash went off, your ISO, your exposure time, your f-stop along with many other settings. We are only looking at the basics as we aren't professionals. Windows 7 allows you to see photo properties. Photo shop paint shop, and many other software allow you to look at your Exif. Photome is a great FREE program to to view your Exif.

To **test** your ability to hold a camera still get a clear glass, fill it 1/3 with water and now hold it up with both hands to see how steady you really are.

I hope this will help you understand and take better photographs at night. Practice and understand what YOUR camera responds to.




