Kestrel

Another tool we use during an investigation is a Kestrel. A Kestrel is a tool that captures accurate and real-time meteorological data such as temperature, wind speed, wind chill, barometric pressure, altitude, wind direction, date/time, and some are equipped with night vision capabilities. This tool is used to assist us in troubleshooting cold spots, finding drafts, debunking activity, etc.

The Kestrel has a propeller and temperature coil built in for accurate reading. The nice thing is that all of these features are captured in one small, mobile phone size package. Since this tool is meant to capture meteorological data they are tough and immune to the elements and can even float if dropped in the water.

Other professions utilize the Kestrel as well, such as fireman, farmers, HVAC technicians, police, and military personnel.
